This is an outside fair running along Route 1 in Kennebunk in front of the Library and beside the First Parish Unitarian Universalist Church. It is a fundraising event for the Church, which has a history of great success with many repeat artisans, music, food and lots more. Thank you for your interest, we hope you will join us.

ALL SPACES WILL BE OUTSIDE. THEY ARE 11'X11'.

RENT IS \$70.00 PER SPACE IF YOU SIGN UP ON THE DAY OF THE FAIR OR \$75.00 AFTER THAT. THIS IS A RAIN OR SHINE EVENT. REFUNDS WILL ONLY BE GRANTED IF YOU / WE FIND A REPLACEMENT FOR YOUR SITE.

Guidelines:

- Requests for multiple adjacent spaces or a corner space will be granted on a first-come basis. There is some shade but you will need to be aware that it may rain or be very hot. We recommend you bring a canopy tent or awning of some kind. You will need to bring your own tables. Electricity is NOT available.
- Spaces will be marked and numbered. You may park close to the church when unloading only. Vehicle parking is available nearby. You may set up as early as you wish. We do not have assistants available. We ask that everyone be ready to receive customers by 9 am. The fair goes on rain or shine. We ask that you clear your space by 5PM.
- There are rest room facilities available. If you are alone we will provide church staff to watch your booth if you need a break. We will offer each booth a cup of coffee and your choice of a blueberry muffin or a piece of blueberry buckle for free. Luncheon and refreshments will be available for purchase and if you order early we will have it delivered to you at your booth.
- You will receive notification of your space and a map of the area in late June or early July. We do our best to accommodate the requests of returning artisans/crafters to have the same space – just be aware that we occasionally re-number the map! If you sign up the day of the fair for the following year, your chances of occupying the same site increases.
