The Finest Kind Lite Trio performs classic country, blues, and honky tonk from 1:00 to 3:00.

Throughout the day, check out our historic building—which housed community meetings in the 1700s—and educational exhibits for all ages. Our neighbors also welcome visitors: Friends of Hope Cemetery & Woods invite you to stroll 72 acres of trails; the Brick Store Museum offers an Historic Walking Tour of Summer Street (meet in their lobby at noon). Kennebunk Free Library hosts a book sale.

The fair benefits First Parish's on-going educational programs and community outreach.
